


CATCHUPWITHLYNDA

SPOTLIGHT ON A SERVICE - New Access

We receive a wide variety of requests for assistance at the Community Centre. Part of our role is to know what local services exist to provide specialist support to members of our community. To help share these services with the people of Laidley we will be spotlighting a different local service in each bulletin. With R U OK day around the corner (11th April) we wanted to use this issue to spotlight New Access. This service provides free low-intensity support to people experiencing life pressures that may be causing them stress or anxiety, such as those listed on their flyer. You don't need to be on a mental health care plan and the service is currently operating in Gatton and Laidley. If you or someone you know may benefit from the service, please get in touch via the contact details on the flyer below.



What is NewAccess?

NewAccess is a program developed by beyondblue that is a free and confidential support service to help you tackle day-to-day pressures. A coach, specially trained and experienced, will support you in setting practical goals that will get you back on track.

At your first appointment, your coach will complete an initial assessment with you and develop a program tailored to your individual needs. Appointments occur over the phone or face-to-face.

Is this program right for me?

On average, 1 in 5 women and 1 in 8 men will experience some level of depression and 1 in 3 women and 1 in 5 men will experience arxiety during their lifetime.

If any of the following are causing you to feel sad, moody, angry or unable to concentrate or sleep this service could be right for you:

- · Change in living arrangements
- · New parent worries
- · Family problems
- · Health concerns or uncertainty
- · Long-term isolation or loneliness
- Financial worries or instability
- · Work stress or uncertainty

How do I access the program?

Take action and speak to a trained coach.

Individuals and families facing unexpected crisis can attend for support. Support may vary but can include food or fuel vouchers.

Support, referral and advocacy for community to connect with services as required in times of need.

SCHOOL HOLS ACTIVITIES

Activities for youth during holidays (dates vary, places limited).

Support for young people (under 21 years) accessing employment including uniforms, haircuts, tools & resume support.

Community spaces for hire.

Every Friday - 9:30 - 12pm.

FREE COMPUTERS & WI-FI

Computers for public use incl. free Wi-Fi.

THREE-SONS TRAINING CAFÉ

Hospitality training and employment support for young people in operational country café.
